Discussion Questions

- 1. To what extent do you think your life has been impacted by the character and decisions of your parents and grandparents, both positively and negatively?
- 2. When have you seen a seemingly small incident in your past (or a friend's past) have a bigger impact than expected?
- 3. Mordecai and Esther probably didn't realize their actions could save an entire nation. How often do you think about the long-term implications of your actions on future generations?
- 4. Both Mordecai's and Esther's actions required risk and courage. What risky or courageous decisions are you facing that could have a positive impact on a future generation?
- 5. If you believed your actions today would leave a legacy for a generation tomorrow, how might you live differently?
