Discussion Questions

1. **Read John 3:16** - most of us are familiar with this verse.. But what does it look like to love ALL people?
2. In this message, James says, "All life is sacred, from the womb to the tomb." Does this change your perspective on others? Your enemies? People that are not like you?
3. **Read Galatians 3:26-28** - We have equal value in the sight of God. Where have you seen instances of inequality in your community or even inside the church?
4. As Christians, we are supposed to be "wearing Jesus". What does this mean?
5. **Actions Steps:**
 - Learn to see people as God sees them.
 - Call out racism, bigotry, inequality, injustice.
 - Ask God to examine your own heart.
6. Which action step will be the most difficult for you? Why? What was the most helpful/encouraging thought or idea from the message this week?
