Discussion Questions

- 1. **Read John 3:16 -** most of us are familiar with this verse.. But what does it look like to love ALL people?
- 2. In this message, James says, "All life is sacred, from the womb to the tomb." Does this change your perspective on others? Your enemies? People that are not like you?
- 3. **Read Galatians 3:26-28** We have equal value in the sight of God. Where have you seen instances of inequality in your community or even inside the church?
- 4. As Christians, we are supposed to be "wearing Jesus". What does this mean?

5. Actions Steps:

- Learn to see people as God sees them.
- Call out racism, bigotry, inequality, injustice.
- Ask God to examine your own heart.
- 6. Which action step will be the most difficult for you? Why? What was the most helpful/encouraging thought or idea from the message this week?
