



Imagine Heaven, Pt. 6: The Biggest Day of Your Life

Many who have had a near death experience (NDE) claim to have had a “life review.” Although these “life reviews” aren’t the final judgment, they certainly foreshadow what we may experience on the Day of Judgment that comes to all. So, what do the Scriptures say about the final Day of Judgment. You may be surprised!

Bottom Line: What is your plan for eternity? Heaven and Hell are real and you have a choice.

Discussion Questions

1. Read **Daniel 7:10** and **Revelation 20:12**. Scripture and NDE accounts describe a book(s) containing your life’s events. How confident or concerned are you about the details being written about you? Why?
2. Read **Psalms 44:20-22; Ecclesiastes 12:14; Luke 8:17; Matthew 12:36; 1 Corinthians 4:4-6; Hebrews 4:13**. Why do you think it is necessary for God to reveal and bring into the open every thought, word, deed, and motive you have ever had? How does the eventual reality of full exposure impact you today?
3. Read **1 John 5:1-5, 10-13; Romans 8:1 and 6:23; Colossians 1:12-14, 19-23**. What is true about your eternity in light of these verses?
4. During the message on Sunday, an opportunity was given for people secure their eternity by placing their faith in Jesus and then being baptized into him (**Galatians 3:26-27**). Did anyone in your group respond to this invitation? Take some time to pray specifically for people in your group and in the church who responded to this invitation.
5. Who in your life do you need to pray for who have yet to make a decision to place their faith and trust in Jesus or to be baptized? Write down their names and keep praying for them personally and as a group over the weeks/months to come.
6. How has your understanding — or even your beliefs — about Heaven changed as a result of reading “Imagine Heaven” and/or the messages/discussions from this series? How will your life be different?
7. How can the group encourage you this week?
