5. What spiritual practices do you need to focus on or reengage with in this next season to grow and strengthen your relationship with Jesus?
6. What was the most challenging idea/thought to you from the message?
7. What was the most helpful/encouraging thought or idea from the message this week? How did it help you?
8. How can the group encourage you this week?
