



The Immeasurable Life, Pt. 2: It Begins Within

Understanding that God wants to give you immeasurably more starts right here. Immeasurably more is possible for you, but not until something happens in you.

Bottom Line: The most powerful you is empowered by God's love for you.

Discussion Questions:

1. If you won the lottery today, what's the first thing you would do?
2. In what area of your life are you desiring "more" right now? How would getting "more" change things for you?
3. How would you define the word "power"? Where do you tend to look for power when you need it?
4. **Read Ephesians 3:14-20.** What is the significance of Paul saying that "power" is in us?
5. Who is the most loving person you have ever known? How did "the love of Christ" give them "power"?
6. In what area of your life do you wish you were filled with more love?
7. Which of the 3 vital relationships (God, believers, non-believers) comes easiest for you? Which is the most challenging? Why?
8. How would your life look different than it currently does if you were truly "filled to the measure of all the fullness of God"? How would that change your family, job, hobby, relationships?
9. What has been the most helpful thought/idea from the message this week? How has that thought/idea helped you?
10. How can the group encourage you this week?
