



### **He's Still\* Got The Whole World In His Hands, Pt. 4: As We Move Forward**

When you are in the middle of a crisis that continues to worsen, a flood of emotions come over you. Uncertainty. Fear. Anxiety. Despair. How do you move forward when there doesn't seem to be any light at the end of the tunnel?

**Bottom Line:** God can be trusted.

#### **Discussion Questions:**

1. Reflecting over the past few weeks, what emotion you've experienced most? What are the things that have fueled that emotion?
2. **Read Daniel 4:17, 32, 35; 5:21 and Job 42:2.** How, if at all, does the sovereignty of God bring you comfort? What are the implications of God's sovereignty in the middle of a crisis?
3. **Read Romans 8:18-28.** Why is it difficult for people to believe that God is working for good? Does this passage promise that everything will be alright?
4. **Read 2 Corinthians 1:3-4, 8-11.** How have you experienced the truths of this passage?
5. **Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-11.** Why do you think people "sow sparingly"? What is the purpose behind God's provision?
6. **Read 2 Corinthians 9:12-14.** Why is generosity linked with "the obedience that accompanies your confession of the gospel of Christ"? What is the end result of generosity?
7. Which points/ideas from the message were most helpful/encouraging to you? How can you apply them in the coming days?
8. How can the group encourage you this week?

\*If time doesn't allow for you to discuss all of these questions, use only the ones you feel would be most helpful for your group.
