

God's Grand Story, Pt. 8: Jesus Ministers

Though few people could put their finger on exactly who Jesus was, everyone had an opinion about the things he did. He came as a powerful teacher who gradually revealed his true identity and demonstrated the kingdom of God though his character, attitudes, words, and deeds.

Bottom Line: Jesus is the promised Messiah, who gave his life to redeem us from sin.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Where (or from whom) did you first learn about Jesus? What was the message you first learned about Jesus?
- 2. As a group, how many miracles of Jesus can you recall?
- 3. Of all the miracles Jesus preformed, which one are you drawn to most and why?
- 4. What purposes did the miracles of Jesus fulfill?
- 5. **Read Mark 2:1-17**. What do you learn about Jesus from this passage? With what character in this passage do you most identify? Why?
- 6. **Read Matthew 1:21; Luke 2:10-11; Mark 10:45; Luke 10:19; John 14:6; and John 20:30-31**. What story do these passages tell?
- 7. If someone asked you to summarize the teachings of Jesus, what would your summary be?
- 8. In your Bible, scan the section headings you find in **Matthew chapters 5-7**. Which of those subject headings jumps out to you most? Why do you think Jesus chose those topics?
- 9. **Read Matthew 7:21-27**. Why do you think Jesus chose to conclude his sermon in this way? In what ways are you building your life on the teachings of Jesus?
- 10. ~What was the most challenging idea/thought to you from the message?
 - ~What was the most helpful/encouraging thought or idea from the message this week? How did it help you?
 - ~How can the group encourage you this week?
