



Part 4: How Can I Effectively Share My Faith?

For followers of Jesus, the desire to share their faith is natural. We want others to know Jesus and to follow him. But how can we do that?

Bottom Line: It is the privilege and responsibility of every follower of Jesus to lead people into a relationship with him.

Discussion Questions:

1. When it comes to sharing your faith, with which statement do you most identify:
 - a. I don't feel comfortable talking about spiritual things with other people
 - b. I share my faith on a regular basis
 - c. I would love to, but I don't know how
 - d. I really don't think we should share our faith with others
 - e. I am open to doing so, but the thought of it scares me to death
2. How would sharing your faith on a regular basis impact you personally?
3. Share an experience when you shared your faith? What happened? How did you feel? How did you see God show up?
4. **Read 1 Peter 3:13-16.** What do you learn about sharing your faith in Christ from this passage? What challenges you most from this passage? What encourages you most? What helps you most?
5. To effectively share your faith with others, you must first be able to share how Jesus has changed your own life. To help organize your story, use the following questions:
 - a. What was your life like before you became a follower of Jesus?
 - b. How did you become a follower of Jesus?
 - c. What has your life been like since becoming a follower of Jesus?
6. What has been the most helpful thought/idea from the message this week? How has that thought/idea helped you?
7. How can the group encourage you this week?
