6. **Read 2 Corinthians 5:21.** The concept of forgiveness can be hard for some of us. Why do you think that is? Which forgiveness is harder to accept - God's forgiveness or a person's? Why?
7. Describe a time when you felt God's presence in your life.
8. What can you do this week that will allow you to see and embrace the wonders of God?
9. How can this group support you this week?
10. What has been the most helpful thought/idea from the message this week? How has that thought/idea helped you?
