



Pt. 3: Why Does Sexuality Matter So Much to Our Culture?

Sexuality has proliferated into every part of our culture; including how we define our identity. Things once regarded as obvious and bedrock virtues have, in recent years, been subject to vigorous criticism and even, in some cases, regarded as heresies. But how did our culture get here? Discussion Questions:

1. What influences shaped you as a child (both positive and negative)?
2. What differences in attitudes and beliefs have you noticed between the generations in your family? How have you addressed these?
3. What widely followed current cultural practice(s) might a person be criticized for not following?
4. **Read 2 Corinthians 11:3-4.** How have false “teachers” (Rousseau, Marx, Darwin, Freud, & Kinsey) tried to deceive the culture, especially Christians?
5. In what ways can you protect yourself and your family from the influence of the culture?
6. **Read Romans 12:1-2.** How should the mind, thoughts, and actions of a Christian be different than non-believers?
7. What is one step you can take this week toward eliminating habits that conform to the world’s pattern?
8. How can this group support you this week?
9. What has been the most helpful thought/idea from the message this week? How has that thought/idea helped you?

*If time doesn’t allow for you to discuss all of these questions, use only the ones you feel would be most helpful for your group.
