4. **Read James 1:21-25.** What can you do to live out these passages?
5. **Read 1 Peter 2:1-2.** What does it mean to desire the pure or spiritual "milk" of the word? What are some ways you can ensure you're receiving this "milk"?
6. Why have so many churches stayed away from speaking about sexuality and gender? What harm can this cause by not speaking about it?
7. Think about a family member or friend that is being discipled by the culture. How can you pray for them this week?
8. What has been the most helpful thought/idea from the message this week? How has that thought/idea helped you?
