

Pt. 7: The Roots of Transgenderism

As we have seen again and again throughout history, Christian people have been discipled by the culture and have adopted the bankrupt worldview that atheistic philosophies have brought to us. We are saturated by humanistic, atheistic ideologies and we are absorbing them. Yet, Scripture warns about this reality repeatedly and, to our benefit, provides the remedy.

Bottom Line: Our beliefs determine our behavior.

- 3. **Read Ephesians 4:11–16 (CSB)** then answer the following questions:
 - What does it mean to "speak in love" (vs. 15)?
 - How does the spirit help you maintain "unity in the faith" (vs.13) with others in your church?
 - What is your responsibility to help others in the body of Christ?
- 4. **Read Ephesians 4:17-24 (CSB)**, Paul described the difference between Christians and Gentiles. How are Christians today to be different than non Christians? What societal influences makes this challenging?
- 5. **Read 2 Corinthians 10:3–5.** What challenges you about this passage? How can you live out this passage?
- 6. To whom do you need to speak the truth lovingly this week?
- 7. What has been the most helpful thought/idea from the message this week? How has that thought/idea helped you?
- 8. How can the group pray for or encourage you this week?
