



On A Mission: Pt. 2; It's In the Invitation

Each of us has been invited to join Jesus on a mission. We don't have to wonder what that mission is because he's told us in scripture. We can have clarity about it. It's the greatest mission of all time!

Bottom Line: A disciple is one who is following Jesus, being changed by Jesus, and is committed to the mission of Jesus.

Discussion Questions:

1. What kind of invitations do you enjoy receiving?
2. For what kind of activities or relationships are people willing to set aside their own agendas to participate in?
3. Using scripture, how can we best determine what a disciple is?
4. **Read Mark 1:17** then breakdown the passage. What did Jesus mean when he said:
 - "follow me"
 - "I will make you"
 - "fishers of men"
5. **Read Luke 14:25 & Matthew 10:37.** How do these passages challenge you?
6. Describe a time in your life where you felt Jesus pulling you away from something that may have had you stuck and into something better.
7. What does Christ expect us to give up in order to follow him?
8. What has been the most helpful thought/idea from the message this week? How has that thought/idea helped you?
9. How can the group encourage you this week?

*If time doesn't allow for you to discuss all of these questions, use only the ones you feel would be most helpful for your group.
