

On A Mission: Pt. 2; It's In the Invitation

- 6. Describe a time in your life where you felt Jesus pulling you away from something that may have had you stuck and into something better.
- 7. What does Christ expect us to give up in order to follow him?
- 8. What has been the most helpful thought/idea from the message this week? How has that thought/idea helped you?
- 9. How can the group encourage you this week?
