Discussion Questions:

4. **Read Romans 8:29.** Spiritual growth and maturity can be measured by a person's level of "Christlikeness". Explain what this means.
5. If someone is committed to the mission of the church, what are they actively doing?
6. **Read Acts 2:42-47.** The early church was very active relationally with each other. Why was this important back then? Why is this important in the modern church?
7. Think about your own life as it relates to the three activities below. Where are you strong & where can you ask God to help you?
 - ▶ Engaging with the Word of God
 - ▶ Relating to the People of God
 - ▶ Cooperating with the Spirit of God
8. What has been the most helpful thought/idea from the message this week? How has that thought/idea helped you?
9. How can the group encourage you this week?
